Explore our Auction Catalogues

Accessing Catalogues: Visit our website to view our catalogues, which are published well in advance of each sale.

Stay Updated: If your initial search doesn't yield the desired item, stay connected, our future sales may have what you are looking for and make sure to subscribe to our catalogue alerts to ensure you never miss a sale.

Register for Bidding

To bid on items, you must create an account and then register for each auction.

Online Bidding: Create an account using your ID and valid bank card for security checks. Then, registering for auctions is just a click away.

Saleroom Bidding: Arrive early to register. Bring your ID if it's your first time, and we'll set up your account and issue a paddle number.

Payment

If your bidding is successful, settle your invoice by:

In-person: Pay at the saleroom during collection.

Online: Use the secure payment page on the Gildings website.

Bank transfer: Direct payment to our Client Account.

Note: Only debit cards accepted—no cash or credit cards.

Viewing or Condition Reports

Saleroom Viewing: Check our website for viewing times listed with each sale. Visit during these times to inspect items, with expert valuers available to assist.

Condition Reports: If you're unable to visit, you can view or request a free condition report for any catalogued item.

Bidding

Online: The 'Bid Live' button will appear on the website about 30 minutes before the sale starts. Click it to join anytime, watch, and listen to the auction, monitor current bids, and use the bid button to participate when your lot is up for sale.

Saleroom: Follow the auction, observe others, and raise your paddle to join the bidding whenever you wish.

Shipping or Collection

If you win, you can use our shipping service or your own transport.

Shipping Estimates: For your convenience our shipping cost estimate is listed beside each lot. Multiple purchases during a sale may bring down the total cost.

2 Viewing or Condition Reports

Check dates and viewing times for upcoming sales at gildings.co.uk/upcoming-auctions/

To view lots in detail you can visit the saleroom at The Mill, Great Bowden Road, Market Harborough LE16 7DE. Auctioneers, valuers, and staff will be on hand to answer any questions you may have. Condition reports are available online. Use the 'Request Condition Report' button on each lot page to submit a form. An auctioneer will examine the lot, provide a detailed report, and additional images if requested. The report will be emailed to you and published on the lot listing.

3 Register for Bidding

4 Bidding

Please be aware a Buyer's Premium is added to the successful hammer price, with possible additional fees. More details at gildings.co.uk/buying-with-gildings/

If bidding in the saleroom, register to get a numbered bidding paddle and raise it for each bid. For online bidding, log on to your account, click the 'Bid Live' button next to the sale on the upcoming auctions page. This button appears about 30 minutes before the auction starts. Follow the on-screen instructions to access the auction and video feed, and use the 'Bid Live' button to place bids throughout the sale: gildings.co.uk/upcoming-auctions/

5 Payment

If you are in our saleroom and all your chosen lots have finished selling, proceed to the cash desk to pay and collect your items. Online bidders will receive an invoice by email, with a link to pay online. Telephone and absentee bidders can choose to receive their invoice by email or post. 6 Shipping or Collection
